- (1) ASME, JSME, China Nuclear Society (CNS) and European Student-Track Leaders will select up to 15 "Qualified Students" from each of the following geographic locations: North America (USA and Canada) , Japan/Asia, China, and Europe (60 students in total). The Qualified Students receive a complimentary conference registration, which includes the CFD seminar, the opening reception, the banquet, and the student technical tour. In addition Qualified Students from each geographic location are awarded grants to meet travel and hotel expenses.
