Speaker Bio:

Dr. Berrien Moore III is an internationally recognized Earth scientist who has been honored by National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA). He received his Bachelor of Science in Mathematics in 1963 from the University of North Carolina and his PhD in Mathematics in 1969 from the University of Virginia. He has published extensively on the global carbon cycle, biogeochemistry, remote sensing, environmental and space policy, and mathematics. He has contributed actively to committees at the National Academy of Science; over the last decade and a half, he served as Chairman of the National Research Council's (NRC's) Committee on International Space Programs of the Space Studies Board that, in collaboration with the European Space Sciences Committee, jointly published *U.S.-Europe Collaboration in Space Science*. He has served NASA through a variety of other positions including Chair of the EOS Payload Advisory Committee, member and Chair of NASA's Earth Science and Applications Committee, Goddard Space Flight Center Review Committee, and member of the Executive Committee for the Earth System Science Study. He currently serves on the JPL Advisory Council.
