

**Minutes: ASME Research & Technology Committee on Water and Steam in Thermal Systems**

**IWC, Orlando, FL, Nov. 18, 2015**

D. Daniels, 1st Vice Chairperson opened the meeting as R. Light, Chairperson was unable to attend this meeting.

The minutes of the spring 2015 meeting have been sent to members and have been posted on the ASME website and were accepted.

A. Banweg presented the committee financials; account balances as of 10/31 are \$58,410.97 for the Main Committee and \$58,239.27 for the Properties Subcommittee.

The Precommissioning Document had been sent out for ballot, and objections discussed and resolved.

ASME is currently undergoing some organizational changes, including a Global Pathway Support (GPS) System Organization that will be used to approve and fund future committee projects. A. Banweg will follow up with ASME and provide more details at the spring 2016 meeting.

C. Layman reported that IWC attendance exceeded 850 people this year. The ASME and the Produced Water sessions were well attended.

Potential topics for IWC 2016 were discussed;

- 1.) What do you test and why
- 2.) Industrial boiler systems basics.

D. Daniels will move to Chairperson of the committee in 2016, and P. Murphy to 1st Vice Chairperson. C. Laymen was elected to 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice Chairperson and R. Bartholomew to Chairperson of the Water Technology subcommittee.

IWC next year will be held 11/7-10/15 in San Antonio, TX.

The next meeting of this Committee is scheduled for April 12-14, 2016 at NIST in Gaithersburg, MD. As previously the Water Technology Subcommittee will meet April 12, 2016 for an all-day working session. The Main Committee and Properties Subcommittee will then meet April 13-14, 2016.
